We know that continuation of studies cannot be stopped by any obstacle. But then the Corona Virus pandemic reared its ugly head and brought the entire nation to a standstill and the educational institutions being the hub of learning and mass gathering was no exception to it. In the wake of this pandemic, on 22 March, 2020, Janata Curfew (Bharat Bandh) was called for which was followed by phases of 'Lockdown' by Government of India to break the chain of Covid 19. Despite all adversity and obstacles, the school took its stand and came up with series of action plans to retain the educational process lest the students should suffer. It is here that our teachers played a vital role by working very hard and implementing the same through all possible ways.
